

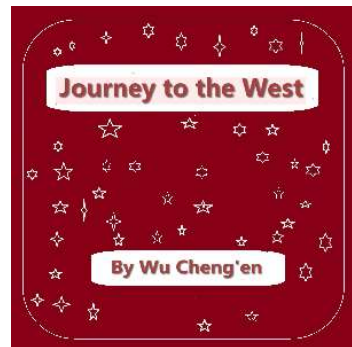

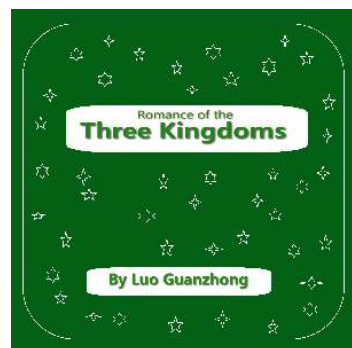

Romance of the Three Kingdoms

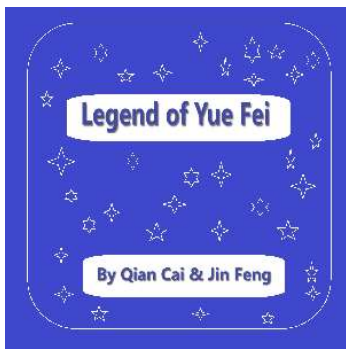

Legend of Yue Fei

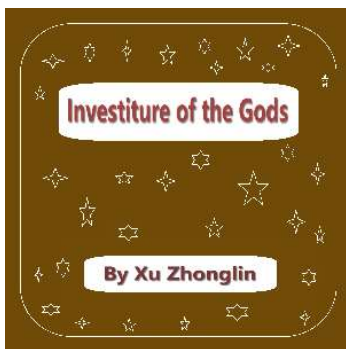

Investiture Of the Gods

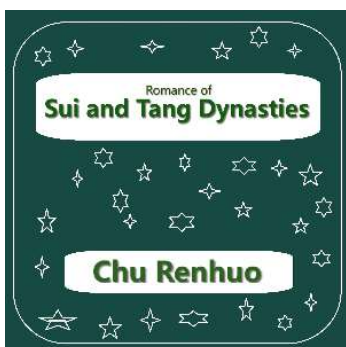

It sets the Pre-Confucian, Pre-Buddhist scene 3000 years ago between the warring Shang and Zhou Dynasties and depicts a grand social and celestial upheaval that contrasts virtue vs vice, love vs lust, loyalty vs betrayal, righteousness vs corruption, benevolence vs cruelty, humility vs envy, gods vs demons, and "Mandate of Heaven" vs tyranny.

Romance of Sui and Tang Dynasties

One of the most popular Chinese Classical Novels by Chu Renhuo. It is a fictionalized account of the turbulent transition from the collapse of the Sui dynasty to the rise of the Tang dynasty. One striking and unique aspect of the novel is that it tells the stories of the women of the era as much as the men: different walks of life, various colours and stripes, from loyal wives, to devoted daughters; from martial women to romantic heroines; from political manipulators to cunning queens, such as

Mulan, Wu Zetian and Yang Guifei and so on. All had their own stories, the good, the bad and the ugly. The novel dramatizes how personal ambition, loyalty, love, jealousy, and moral choices, men and women alike, tangle in karmic cycles and shape history.

Considered the Pinnacle of Chinese Literature this novel is an 18th-century Chinese masterpiece by Cao Xueqin. It chronicles the rise and fall of the noble Jia clan, focusing on the tragic love triangle between the idealistic Jia Baoyu and his cousins Lin Daiyu and Xue Baochai, set against a backdrop of opulence and eventual familial ruin. The novel presents a thought-provoking view that wealth, fame, career, and romantic love are dream-like, fleeting, and "transient". Only being virtuous can make a difference.




The Legend of Jigong
